



Charging







 Insert the USB charging cable's Micro USB plug into the charging port on your headphones.



3. Insert the USB charging cable's standard USB plug into the USB port of a computer or suitable USB charging adapter.




4. The LED Indicator light will turn red while the headphones are charging. When charging is complete the light will turn off.

NOTES:

- $\mbox{--}$ Charging can take approximately two hours to complete when the battery is fully drained.
- -- Remove the charging cable once charging is complete.
- -- Overcharging could reduce the life of the battery.
- -- A charged battery will lose its capacity if it is not used on a regular basis.

Important: To avoid a complete discharge of the battery, charge your headphones at least once every six months.


Bluetooth Pairing




1. Press and hold the Play/ Pause button for 1-2 seconds to turn your headphones ON.



2. The LED Indicator will alternately flash red and blue to indicate your headphones are in pairing mode.




3. Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the available device listed as "ANC Headphone".




4. The LED Indicator will turn solid blue to indicate your headphones are paired with your phone.


Using Your Headphones



 Press and hold the Play/Pause button for 1-2 seconds to turn your headphones ON and OFF.




2. Press the Play/Pause button to play a track. Press the button again to pause a track.


3. Press the - ◀ button to decrease volume. Press and hold to go to the

6. Slide the Noise Cancellation Switch left and right to turn the feature on or off. The LED Indicator will turn green when turned ON.
